

WSC COVID-19 Information

Entry, Exit and Flow: PLEASE, Please be patient when entering and exiting.

Follow all marked flow patterns for entry, exit, restrooms and snack bar. We are utilizing Social Distancing Fish (SDF) for 2020! Keep your eyes out for our signature fish to denote spacing among members. Additionally, you will see traffic flow arrows that are painted on the ground. We are promoting a ONE WAY traffic pattern in common areas, please keep this in mind especially when **entering the bathrooms (use the main hallway)** and then to **exit the bathrooms please use the exterior bathroom doors.**

WSC Personnel training: All staff members will be trained and equipped on COVID19 protocols, awareness, cleaning, and sanitizing. All staff members will be required to do temperature screenings and ensure they do not have any COVID symptoms. All staff members will be required to wash their hands frequently. Look for our Supervisor Lifeguard Tent (SLT) as you enter the club. In this area, you can meet our new manager Brianna Hough, as well as say hello to our adult supervisors. This area will also have sanitizer for your convenience, means to contact our sanitizing guard as well as be a check in spot for our Social Distancing Ambassador.

Life guards and Personnel: There will be at least 1 manager or adult supervisor on duty at all times during normal operating hours. There will be 3 guards watching over the pools, 2 at the main pool and 1 at the baby pool at all times, when pools are open. There will be 1 person maintaining the front desk check in area and 1 person disinfecting. Remember our staff consists of our members' children; Treat them like you would want someone to treat your children. Please be helpful and kind.

Members and guest admittance: Make sure to have some form of identification and any fees that may need to be paid when entering. Guest fees will be \$5.00 a day.

Upon your first visit this season we will ask you to update your family census if this has not been completed as well as sign a 2020 waiver. The census and waiver are attached for your convenience. . All guests need to fill out the COVID waiver, upon check in. Waivers do not need to be notarized Please be patient during the check in process.

Children at swim club: All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by someone over the age of 12. Children 12 and older must have a high band, to be left alone at the swim club or to be able to be responsible for watching children under 12. The swim club is not responsible for watching your children or guests.

Tables, chairs, & grounds: Ground occupancy, tables, and chairs have been spread out to accommodate members and guests, **please do not relocate any chair or tables, including the lounge chairs.** Each table will have 4 chairs, please make sure chairs stay with the assigned table, if additional chairs are needed feel free to bring your own personal chairs. There will be **no saving** of tables or chairs. Each table will have an assigned number. Tables will be assigned during entry. You will be given a table number corresponding to where you will sit, comparable to restaurant seating. When leaving, you must inform the front desk staff member that you are no longer using your assigned table and chairs and please return your table number into the table number holder across from the check in counter. This will ensure proper cleaning of your table and chairs prior to another member being assigned your previously occupied table. Lounge chairs, like all furniture, will be cleaned prior to opening. If you plan to utilize a lounge chair while visiting the club, please bring a towel to lay on and request cleaner for the lounge chair at the end of your stay; you can visit the SLT for information. **Our furniture is very expensive, please take care of it.**

Pool occupancy: Based on the size of our pools, our main pool can accommodate 70 or more patrons at one time and our baby pool can accommodate up to 20 patrons. Children with bands will not be permitted in the baby pool. Parents or responsible parties must accompany all children in the baby pool and children without a high band in the main pool. All pools are subject to changing occupancy, based on safety concerns.

Diving boards: **It looks like we will be able to open our diving boards on July 2, 2020.** Diving boards railing will be sprayed with chlorinated pool water to sanitize railings.

Sanitizing: Hand sanitizer will be placed in designated locations, for members and guest use. Sinks in bathrooms have antibacterial soap and paper towels. Disinfectants will be available. There will be one staff member designated to perform routine cleanings of all high touch surfaces per shift. All tables and chairs will be cleaned after being used.

Snack Bar is Open: Snack bar is open from 12 until 8 with the grill open for periods of the afternoon and evening. **The grill will be open daily, weather permitting, from 12 until 7.** If you are 16 or older and looking for a grill job- please email wenonahswimming@gmail.com. The menu is posted and we are adding new items each week!

Restrooms and showers: Restrooms will have reduced occupancy. Only 2 persons or one family in the shower area at one time. The restroom area will be limited to 2 persons at one time. Foot coverings are required while in restrooms and or showers.

Face masks: Lifeguards will not be required to wear face coverings. Patrons are encouraged to wear face coverings, but not required. Face covering should not be worn in pools. Staff members handling food will wear gloves and wear face coverings.

Social Distancing: All members and guests are encouraged to maintain social distancing of a minimum of 6 feet. Signs are posted to remind members and guests. There will be markings in designated areas to remind members and guests to keep six feet social distancing. Keep an eye out for our SDF marking the spots for chairs surrounding the baby pool.

Toys and sports equipment: Toys and sports supplies will not be supplied by the swim club. You can bring your own toys and or sports equipment. No toys, sports equipment, or floats will be permitted in the main pool.
